## New Arrivals:

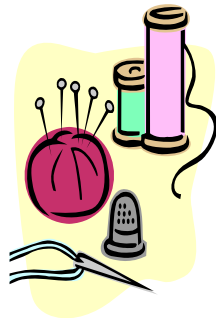
